








- EHS (ergonomics):
 - daily handling of app. 70 trolleys
 - with 420 trays / hour
 - each tray app. 2,5 kg between 30 cm above floor to 1,60m in height
- Business | ROI < 7

Space restrictions

- room designed for minimal transport & cleaning
- no extension area

Process tolerances


- trolleys

Schedule

- seasonal product
- time critical (9 weeks total)

Safety / Cleaning


- safe operation (dark room)

- ✓ acceleration control





